Job Summary:

This position is open for individuals who desire to be trained in fiber optic splicing. This is a full time position with the company. We will be train you on our methods of fiber optic splicing equipment and use of an Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) which is used for testing the integrity of fiber optic cables. It can verify splice loss, measure length and find faults. Diagnosing network fiber breaks. Analyze and resolve fiber optic splicing issues and breaks in the fiber optic backbone and provide support to other technical personnel as needed to ensure 24x7 system availability and security.

This position is Monday thru Friday, with afterhours required to complete installations, maintenance and outages, some overtime work will apply. Starting pay rate: \$12.00 per hour with time and a half for overtime. If you do not live within the service area you will be provided with lodging and a per diem for food.

Desired Skills:

- Experience with splicing or cabling and ODTR is not necessary but desirable; Windwave will train individuals for these skills.
- Acts as an "in the field" service technician.
- An understanding of network and system monitoring tools.
- The ability to plan, splice, and implement testing on OTDR equipment
- Highly desired experience with wire management, punch downs, circuit terminations, etc also desired, experience installing Network Cabling Infrastructure utilizing CAT-5, and CAT-6 cabling.
- Complete technical documentation of processes and OTDR Testing of fiber optic splices
- Available to participate in shift work.
- Perform basic troubleshooting
- Update changes to current documentation
- Meticulous tendencies within the work area are mandatory
